This firm represents the Alligator Point Water Resources District in Franklin County, Florida. On or about March 13, 2015 we were served with a subpoena for production of documents addressed to the Alligator Point Water Resources District.

The District has one office manager, one maintenance person and one part time engineer. It is very difficult to timely respond to this production request.

I am directed to determine provisions under the applicable rules, or your management plans, to pay costs and fees incurred in responding to this request.
