Notice of Correction of Clerical Error in Tenth Circuit Rule 30.3(A)

Due to a clerical error, Tenth Circuit Rule 30.3(A) was not updated to reflect the court's current practice of requiring paper copies, when ordered, to be received in the Clerk's Office and served on other parties within five calendar days rather than five business days. Rule 30.3(A) has been updated as follows.

30.3 Appendix exemptions.

(A) Waiver of electronic appendix requirement. Any party may move to be exempt from the electronic appendix requirement by filing a motion at least 7 days prior to the due date for the principal brief and appendix. Except as provided in Rule 30.1(B)(2) for Social Security cases, if an exemption is granted, two hard copies of the required appendix must be filed with the Clerk within 5 business days following issuance of notice that the electronic brief is compliant. A hard copy of the appendix must be served on all other parties to the appeal within that same 5 business day period.
